What is the Neighbourhood Plan?

A very real opportunity for Pirton residents to have their say in the future of the village over the next 15-20 years. See more information in the questionnaire.

What's the Questionnaire about/why another questionnaire?

The Questionnaire is an essential requirement for the Pirton Neighbourhood Plan. Through this questionnaire the Steering Group can find out what the people of Pirton currently think about how Pirton should look and be like to live in over the next 15-20 years. It's the most important questionnaire Pirton has ever had, as it will help to shape the NP. Lots **more information in the questionnaire and phone no. of who to contact if you need to know more or are not clear about something.**

What is the date of collection of the completed questionnaire?

Reps will be collecting completed questionnaires during the weekend of 29th & 30th November. If no one is home the rep will post a card through the door giving a number to phone to organise a further collection time. If person likely to be away over the whole period they can also phone to make alternative collection arrangements.

Why is there no online option to complete?

We need to have a mechanism to ensure that no individual can complete more than one questionnaire. If we were to both deliver questionnaires to houses and allow an online version to be completed, we could not make a declaration that only one questionnaire per person was completed. Also, an online version would not allow the person to remain anonymous, and could not be restricted to Pirton residents, without asking for proof of identity.

Confidentiality

We won't be matching answers to your address, as the form does not require you to enter your address. We guarantee that the content will only be used by our Professional Market Researcher. Individual responses won't be reported but will be analysed alongside everyone else's in the village. **More info in the questionnaire**

Feedback information -

When our Market Researcher has analysed all the results, a public meeting will be arranged to give the information and answer any questions. There will also be a leaflet coming through your letterbox announcing the date of this public meeting, and information will appear in the Parish magazine, Pirton Website, The NP website and Facebook. **More info in questionnaire**

Why do you need our household information?

There is a very limited level of information being asked for, but it will provide an overall profile of the village community, without being specific on personal information. We can also show we have taken the views of as many people as possible, into consideration

Refusal to fill in

That's up to the individual and no one must be forced into accepting a questionnaire. However, it should be pointed out that if they choose not to have one to complete, the Steering Group will not be able to take their views into account when drafting the Neighbourhood Plan
Would they like to take one for other members of the family?

Why do we all need to fill one in?

Because it's important we have everyone's personal view and opinion – individual family members may have different views.

Why do the kids need to fill one in?

Young people have different needs and ideas from those of adults. It is important we hear their opinions as well.
