

The Objectives of the Pirton Neighbourhood Plan

1.To ensure managed mixed housing growth that encompasses the needs of all ages and social strata.

2.To ensure sensitive development in accordance with the existing character of Pirton village and Parish, including its greenery, wildlife habitats and connectivity, landscape and access to the countryside.

3.To maintain Pirton Parish as a safe place to live including pedestrian and vehicle safety on our narrow roads

4.To preserve and enhance Pirton's centuries of heritage

5.To protect and enhance the local landscape of the Parish of Pirton

6. To ensure that all proposals conserve and enhance the special character, heritage, landscape and distinctiveness of the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

7. To preserve and protect Pirton Village's distinctive rural position and character and maintain separation from other centres of population

8. To maintain the distinctive views on entering and leaving Pirton Village, and within the village itself.

9. To protect important green and open spaces within the Pirton village and Parish

10. To support, maintain and develop community facilities for all ages

11. To encourage small businesses and home working and seek improvements in the supporting infrastructure e.g. digital connectivity

12. To support the rural economy

13. To involve the local community on an on-going basis in the process of plan making, monitoring and delivery of development
